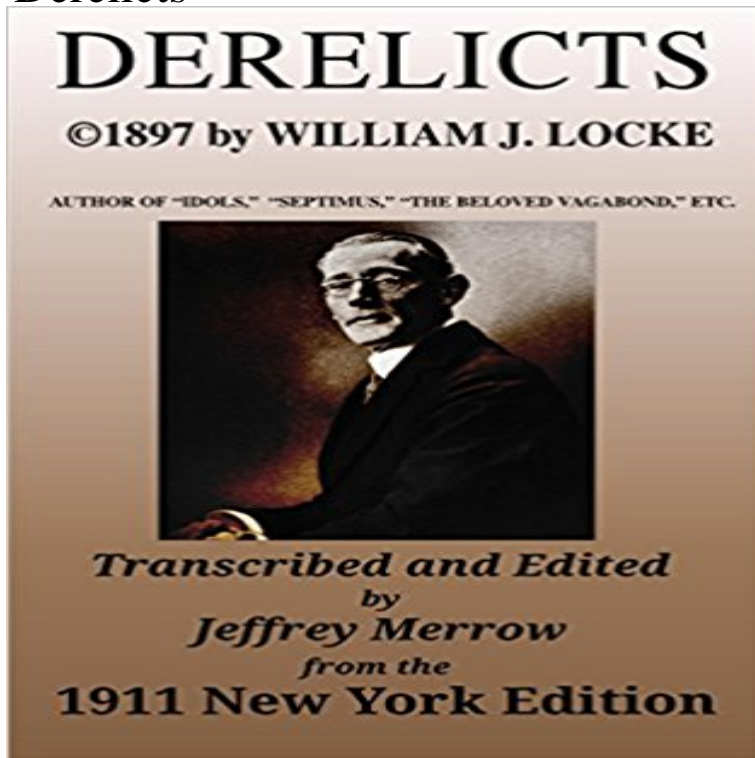


Derelicts
