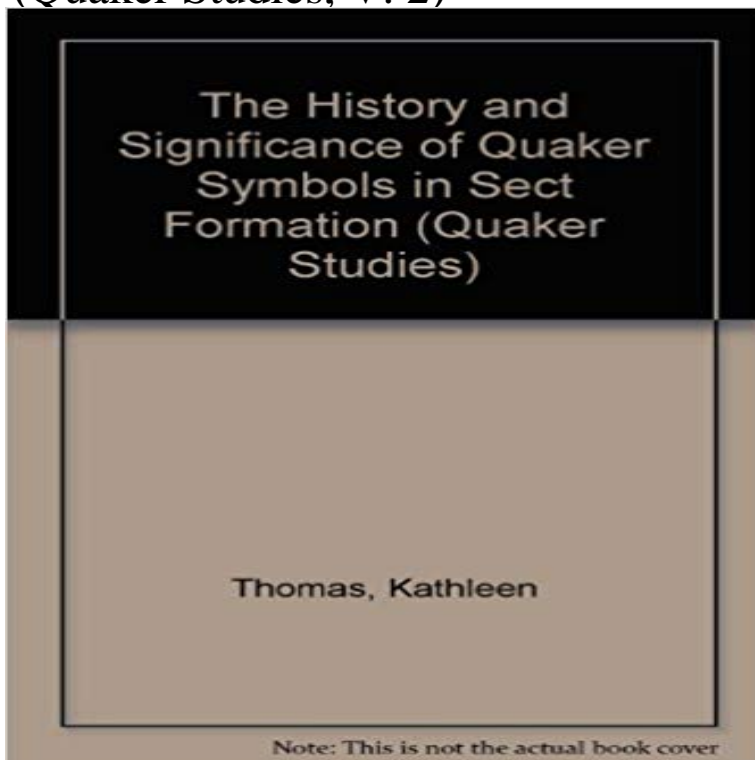


# The History and Significance of Quaker Symbols in Sect Formation (Quaker Studies, V. 2)
