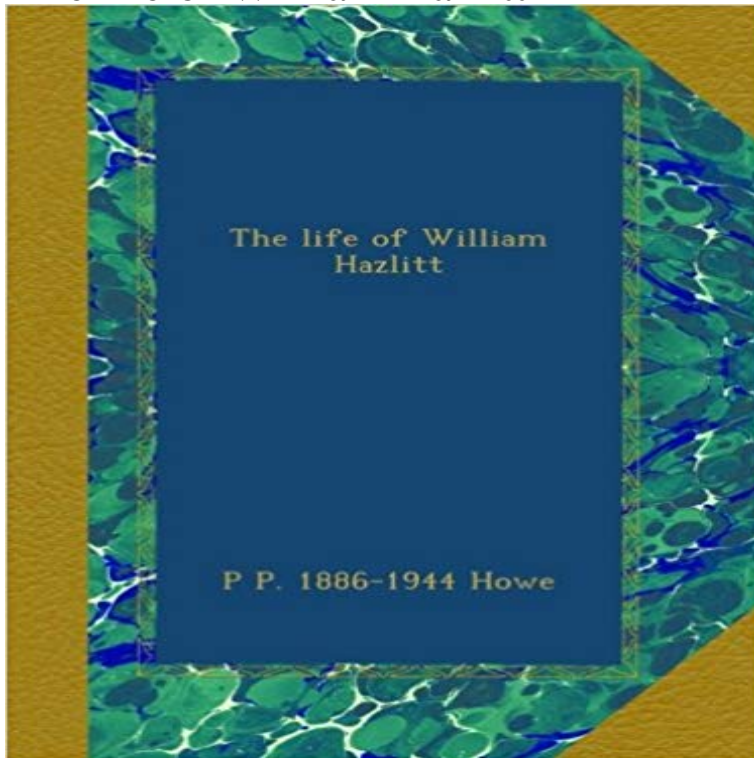


The life of William Hazlitt
